MEDICAL EMERGENCY TREATMENT SLIP

I hereby authorize the above physician and/or designated associates or assistant or their covering physicians, or in the event these persons cannot be contacted, the emergency physician on duty at the hospital to provide emergency treatment to our child for the following:

1. Any laceration, fracture or other traumatic injury; or
2. Any symptom, disease or injury which, in the judgement of the attending physician, if untreated, reasonably may be expected to increase the risk of or threaten the health or life of the child, or threaten disfigurement or impairment of his/her facilities.

No major surgery or life threatening procedures may be performed upon my child and no general anesthesia may be administered unless:

1. The life or health of my child is in danger; or if delaying such treatment to obtain consent would create a threat of serious injury to the health of my child; and
2. The attending physician and one other physician consult and agree that such treatment is necessary for the health of my child.

I hereby give my consent for admission of my child to:

If, in the judgement of the attending physician, it is necessary for any treatment authorized herein.

This consent is to be effective only after reasonable efforts have been made to contact me and obtain my specific consent to any emergency treatment. This consent is also to be used in conjunction with the hospital's procedure for documented administrative authorization.

HAMBURG JUNIOR POLICE ACADEMY Rules and Regulations

1. Applicants for membership in the Hamburg Junior Police Academy is open to fifth through eighth grade Hamburg students.
2. Doctor's Release Form must be signed by both doctor and parent.
3. Cadets shall maintain regulation uniforms. Uniforms shall be kept neat, clean, and well pressed at all times.
4. Cadets are required to attend the training of the Junior Police Academy. Cadets who did not attend school on the day of training for an unexcused absence, Example: out sick, in-school suspension, out of school suspension, will not be permitted to participate for the evening.
5. Fighting is forbidden. Any cadet fighting will be removed from the program.
6. Cadets found using cigarettes, chewing tobacco, etc., will be removed from the program.
7. Any cadet missing three meetings without an approved reason will be dropped from the program.
8. Hair will be kept in a neat and trimmed fashion.
9. Cadets are expected to maintain school grades.
10. Criminal activity will not be tolerated. If this occurs, the cadet will be dismissed.
11. **No disrespect of fellow Junior Police Academy members will be tolerated by anyone. This program is designed for you to have fun and learn.**
